

### **Prorated Continuing Education Hours**

Licenses expire on last calendar day of your birth month. On-time renewal of licensure will be for two (2) years and will expire the last day of your birth month. For initial licensure (by examination or endorsement) or reinstatement of a lapsed license, licensure may be for less than two (2) years in order to place the expiration on the birth month.

In cases when licensure is for less than two (2) years, the Continuing Education component of the Continuing Competence requirements is prorated according to the following schedule.

NOTE: There is no allowance for prorating worked hours or any other elements within the Continuing Competence Learning Options.
